










































Streetscape Design Team Organization Chart

Central Broadway Project Approach

- Review and confirm previous work
 - 2012 MIT study
 - 2008 Zoning study
 - East Broadway improvements
 - Magoun Square improvements
- Gather existing conditions
 - Topographic survey
 - Investigate utilities
 - Examine traffic and safety issues













Central Broadway Project Approach

- Transportation study
 - Traffic Analysis
 - Safety analysis
 - Site inventory
 - Bus stops, bike racks, green space, parking, loading zones, etc.










Winter Hill/Magoun Square Neighborhood Plan 2012 Recommendations - Roadway

Winter Hill/Magoun Square Neighborhood Plan 2012 Recommendations - Landscaping

Linear park:

- Address need for green space in this neighborhood
- Opportunity for aesthetic improvement along corridor
- Strengthens sense of place, accessibility, and connectivity
- Complement and connect
 Trum Field and Foss Park










Project Approach – Traffic Data Collection and Modeling

- Traffic counts
 - Vehicle type
 - Speed
 - Manual & Automatic Traffic Recorders (ATR)
 - Weekday AM/mid-day/PM; Saturday mid-day
- Parking regulations & activities
- Delivery activities
- Transit activities (bus occupancies, boardings)
- Road Safety Audit ("walking audit")
- Current conditions inform future options
- Develop traffic flow maps
- Intersection analyses and simulation modeling














Project Approach – Traffic Goals

- Develop Context Sensitive, "Complete Street" Solution for the corridor
 - Balance the needs of pedestrian, transit, & parking
 - Propose improvement schemes to the appropriate "scale" for Broadway
- Lead the development of transit, biking, & parking improvements
- Support our landscape architects for pedestrian space & sidewalk initiatives
